This is the fourth volume in the series of books on the Southeast Asian water environment.

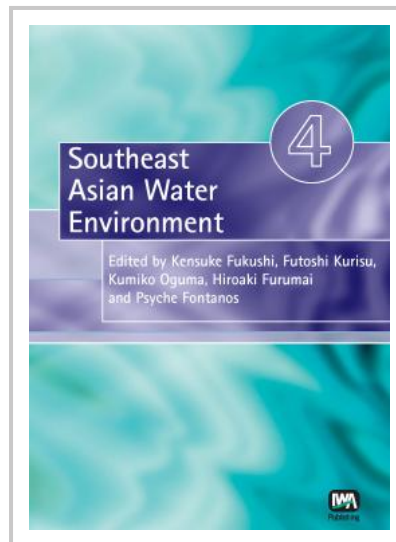
