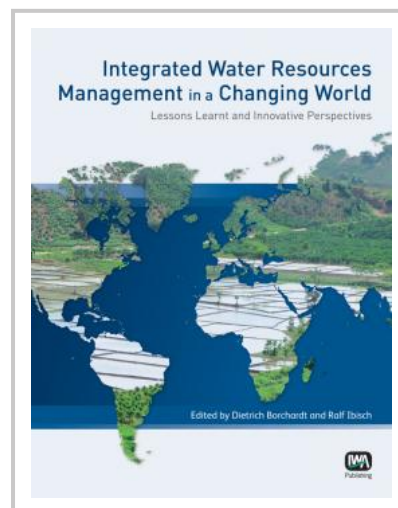


Integrated Water Resources Management in a Changing World
