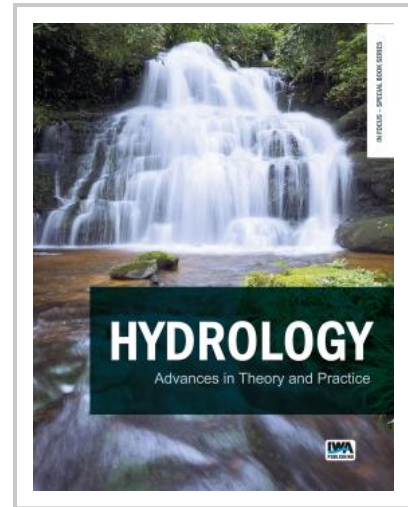


# Hydrology: Advances in Theory and Practice
