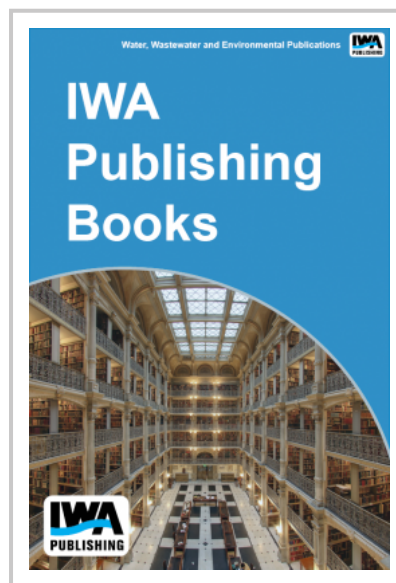


Best Practice Guide on Control of Fluoride in Drinking Water
