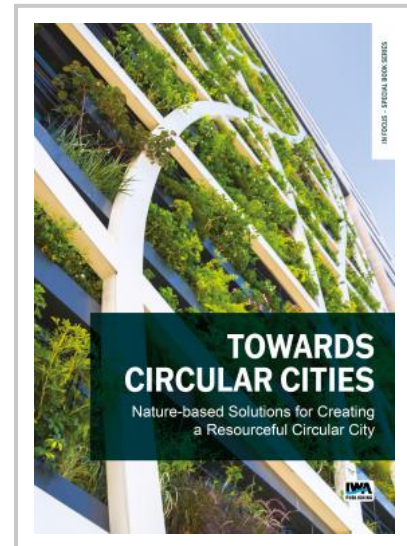


Towards Circular Cities: Nature based solutions for creating a resourceful circular city
